People need to be reminded to contribute to Concern. The Women's Retreat at Camp Christian has a project to collect items for the Inside-Out Program, for women who have just been released from prison. Next week they will meet with St. James, St. Johns and Emmanuel Lutheran churches for a meal and to work on Soctober, an event where they will collect new socks and donate them to a homeless shelter. Mike gave the Stewardship report. He would like to have budget requests from the commissions to help determine what will be needed for next year's budget. There are some stewardship booklets which families have been asked to take home and look at in preparation for making a pledge.
