

DCC ALCOHOL POLICY

1. Alcohol is permitted on the premises and grounds of DCC, subject to the terms of this Policy and the Alcohol Policy Use Agreement. Alcohol that is permitted does not include any alcoholic beverages that exceed 15% alcohol by volume. Hard liquor is not allowed. No alcohol will be served by or to any person under the legal age of 21.
2. Regular Sunday worship services will remain alcohol free as they presently are and only non-alcoholic beverages will be used as communion at these services.
3. Alcohol may be served at special DCC services and celebrations, such as the Seder meal, fundraisers, annual birthday party, etc. The use of alcohol at these DCC events is at the discretion of the person(s) in charge of the event.
4. Alcohol may be served at private functions such as weddings, funerals, graduations, etc. The person(s) in charge of the function must sign a DCC Alcohol Policy Use Agreement.
5. Alcohol may not be brought to DCC before the day of the service, celebration or function, and must be removed from the premises at the conclusion of the event.

ALCOHOL POLICY USE AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made between Disciples Christian Church, hereinafter called DCC, and _____, hereinafter called User.

DCC agree to permit User to serve alcoholic beverages not exceeding 15% alcohol by volume at its function to be held on the _____ day of _____, subject to the following conditions:

1. User agrees to release and hold harmless DCC and its officers, employees, members, agents and successors from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, expenses or liability arising under any cause of claimed theory of law for any and all actions, or the results of such actions, in which the User or User's guest(s) may be involved relating to the use of the DCC facilities.
2. Alcohol will not be brought to DCC before the day of the User's function and must be removed from DCC's premises at the conclusion of the function.
3. User will be responsible for cleaning those parts of DCC's premises that have been used by the User and User's guest(s) and for restoring the premises to the condition they were in prior to the User's function.
4. Hard liquor is not allowed on the premises of DCC and no alcohol will be served by or to any person under the age of 21.
